SECRET GENIUS settled off the rail, moved up outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up, gained a slim advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. ADDENDUM prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival on the backstretch, bid alongside the pacesetter on the turn, took the advantage nearing the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. NO TRICKS FOR JACK pulled her way along inside and was in a bit tight off heels midway on the backstretch, came out on the turn and into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and picked up the show. INNER GROOVE chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. HALFAPONDAROSA pressed then staled the pace inside, saved ground on the turn, came out some into the stretch and weakened. TIP YOUR HAT sped to the early lead, set the pace between horses then inched away on the backstretch, angled in nearing the turn, duelled inside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
