CHOSEN MIRACLE sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival then stalked just off the inside, bid again alongside that one into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and held under urging. DUBAI YOU X Y Z chased between horses down the hill, came out some into the stretch, came out off heels nearing midstretch and gained the place. STARSPANGLED HEAT settled outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and edged foes for the show. KOAST saved ground chasing the pace, waited off heels on the dirt crossing and into the stretch and again in midstretch, came out for room and was edged for third. CARBONITE stalked outside a rival then three deep leaving the hill, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. GRAND BERRY (ARG) went up inside the winner to duel for the lead, inched away leaving the hill, fought back along the inside into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CHARLEMAGNE WOOD (IRE) chased just off the rail down the hill, came out into the stretch and did not rally. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
