Footnotes

ENGLISH RHYTHM chased between horses, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up between foes late. TANQUERRAY chased outside or off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well three deep on the line. CUVEE EXCHANGE stalked three deep then outside a rival leaving the second turn, bid alongside a foe to put a head in front in midstretch, fought back inside the top pair in deep stretch and continued gamely to the end. BONITA SONADOR stalked outside a rival then bid alongside a foe to duel for the lead, took the advantage on the second turn, inched away leaving that turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late. SWEET BAGUETTE chased inside then off the rail leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. BRITENESS had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, continued a bit off the rail under urging in the drive, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out and lacked the needed response. WARREN'S LOVER settled outside a rival then inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally.

CAT PIRATE pulled early, chased outside a rival or between foes, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. SUANCES VIXEN pulled her way between horses and steadied off heels nearing the first turn, stalked three deep, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. SHEWHOMUSTBEOBEYED had speed outside then inched away and angled in, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back leaving that turn, gave way in the stretch and was eased in the final furlong.
