BLUESTHESTANDARD stalked outside on the backstretch, moved up outside on the turn, took a short lead three deep, battled outside a rival into the stretch and until deep stretch, then inched clear under left handed urging while drifting out late. JOEY FRANCO between horses early, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail on the turn and through the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. KONA GOLD chased outside then off the rail on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and just missed the place. DEBONAIR JOE settled inside, went around a rival into the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. D'WILDCAT between horses early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the turn, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. F J'S PACE forced the pace outside a rival early then stalked that one off the rail, bid between horses on the turn, dropped back approaching the stretch and weakened. MARTEL sent to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes nearing midway on the turn and gave way.
