ANNA YOU'RE UP stalked the pace three deep then outside a rival leaving the second turn, took the lead alongside the pacesetter nearing midstretch and won clear under left handed urging. WARREN'S LOVER saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and went between rivals late for the place. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR broke awkwardly then bobbled, pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. LIKA prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, came out and steadied off heels three deep into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished late for a minor award. LORENBRAY had speed between foes then angled in and set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch and weakened some. STORMY ANNA pulled her way between foes early, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and between horses on the second turn and lacked a rally in the lane. QUIET ADVICE had speed between rivals then stalked inside to the stretch and weakened.
