STRAIGHT MAN sprinted to the early lead, led throughout along the inside, kicked clear and proved best under a strong hand ride. OUTSTANDING HERO settled early, was sent between horses leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was game for the place. PATIENCE GAME stalked the winner along the inside, came out some into the stretch, could not catch that rival and just lost second. LETHAL INSTRUMENT settled off the rail, angled in and inched forward leaving the backstretch and on the turn but lacked the needed late response. TIMBER BARON chased outside on the backstretch and four wide nearing the turn, angled inward in upper stretch and did not rally. MARGEDS DANCER stalked the pace off the rail or between horses, continued outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. DIAMANT (ARG) unhurried outside early, angled in for the turn, came out for the stretch and did not rally. ACTIN TIME broke through the gate before the start, stalked the pace three deep, dropped back on the turn, drifted out into the stretch, gave way and was not abused in the stretch.
