### Footnotes

MUSIC'S STORM quickly stepped to the front and dictated the pace a bit off the fence, cleared nearing midstretch and safely held while kept to task. JUSTASTORM unhurried from the inside, came off the rail on the turn and finished strongly to prove second best. OUR NEW RECRUIT pressured the pacesetter while a bit off the rail, was hard asked to remain in contact around the bend but weakened from along the rail. MONEYWASTER broke out and lagged back in the early stages, raced off the rail throughout and was never a threat. MAMONE unhurried leaving the gate, was trying to lug in leaving the chute and under a tight pull to be straightened away, then weakened from the inside. CARSON CITY SLEW pressed the pace from along the rail into the turn, dropped back, then broke down on the bend and was vanned off.
