Footnotes

REVILLEW SLEW well positioned while saving ground to the final turn, swung out for room in upper stretch and responded when roused to be along in time. ONACCOUNTOFYOU unhurried while between rivals in the early stages, advanced three wide around the last bend and into the stretch, then finished very willingly to gain second at the wire. BOLD ROBERTA broke in and a bit awkward, was sent up from outside to prompt the pace, remained three wide, loomed outside pacesetter passing midstretch and finished gamely. CHIME AFTER CHIME stepped to the front and rated from just off the rail, edged away nearing the stretch, dug in bravely through the drive but could not stave off rivals. DAZZLING DIAMONDS sent up to prompt the early issue outside the pacesetter, remained prominent into the lane but weakened. ELLA'S PAL (GB) settled off the rail, then angled in some and raced outside foe to the stretch and finished very willingly. ARROW ANGEL (NZ) reserved early from along the rail, never reached contention and drifted out through the drive. UP AT THE

TOP (IRE) lagged back while three wide leaving the backstretch and four wide into the stretch, then was forced out through the drive. TUTELADA (BRZ) saved ground throughout but never reached contention. RAIN DANCER (NZ) was slow into stride, reserved three wide early, later raced four wide leaving the second turn and lacked any late response. LOTTA PAY had a ground-saving trip but was outrun.
