Footnotes

DREAM LADY took the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, shook loose on the second turn, was shown the whip in midstretch and won clear under a steady hand ride. DALICIA (GER) broke slowly, chased between horses, waited a bit leaving the second turn then found room inside into the stretch and gained the place. CARINI (GB) off a bit slowly, pulled her way between horses then chased just out from the inside, continued off the rail in the stretch and bested the rest. IMMORTALITE (PER) saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, then drifted out through the drive and weakened. MEMORETTE chased between foes then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AGATA (FR) pulled early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DANCLARE pulled outside early then moved up three deep to stalk the pace, continued outside on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and also weakened.
