Footnotes

DERBY GOLD had speed off the rail then stalked off the inside, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and drew clear under urging. THE BLACK chased outside then four wide, went three deep on the turn, angled in outside a rival into the stretch, went around a pair of foes in deep stretch and gained the place. REAL CONUNDRUM sent inside to chase the pace, saved ground on the turn, inched up along the rail in the stretch and held third. PULPIT'S EXPRESS sent between horses to the early lead, set the pace inside, came off the fence into the stretch, was between rivals a sixteenth out and weakened. PASSING GAME chased between rivals and was in a bit tight on the backstretch, continued just off the rail on the turn, came out leaving the bend and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. THREE VASES pulled some early and stalked outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. COACH BOB between foes early, stalked off the rail, came out some in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. A TOAST TO YOU bobbled in a bit of a slow start, settled outside a rival then three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BENCH LIGHT broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, split horses into the stretch and was not a threat. EXOTIC SLEW chased between horses or a bit off the rail, split foes again nearing the turn and weakened in the stretch. G'NIGHT between foes early, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in nearing the turn and weakened in the drive.
