Footnotes

UBELONGTOMEMISSY fractious in the gate, chased UBELONGTOMEMISSY outside a rival then off the rail, moved up on the second turn and into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up to gain the lead in midstretch and inched away under some left handed urging late while lugging in some. NIGHT DANCE pulled her way along three deep then pressed the pace outside a rival, let that one slip away briefly a half mile out then re-bid and surged to the front on the second turn, angled in, fought back along the inside in the stretch but could not match the winner late. WARREN'S LORIE S. pulled her way along off the rail and steadied into the first turn, angled in then came out leaving that turn, chased outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. O HAPPY GRAY between horses early, stalked just off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BENCH BEAUTY had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away briefly on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased up in the late stages.
