Footnotes

YES HE'S A PISTOL stalked outside a rival then bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, dueled alongside that one on the second turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and pulled clear under urging. SKYE'N THUNDER close up stalking the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, was between foes past midstretch, could not match the winner but edged a rival for the place. SEAPOINT angled in and chased outside a rival, was in a bit tight off heels between foes early on the backstretch, continued outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and was edged for second. SLEWSBAG chased inside, swung out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PURE AS GOLD broke outward, settled to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside to the stretch and weakened. DONNYBROOK PRIDE three deep into the first turn, speared outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. HAMMER BACK steadied when squeezed back at the start, went four wide into the first turn then angled in and chased off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. CONCERT MASTER bobbled at the start, pulled his way along outside a rival then three deep chasing the pace on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
