Footnotes

RED ALERT DAY (GB) stalked the pace inside, awaited room leaving the second turn, bid between horses then outside a rival in the stretch, took the lead past the eighth pole and proved best under good handling. HUGHESY chased outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn, was fanned four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SIR DAVE pulled when wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out leaving the second turn, was fanned six wide into the stretch and gained the show late. NO STADIUM had speed outside then angled in a nd set the pace inside, fought back when challenged on the second turn and again in midstretch and weakened some late but just lost the show. VICTORIAN PRINCE (IRE) chased inside, came a bit off the rail into the second turn, waited between foes then clipped heels a quarter mile out, came out three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. INTERPATATION chased off the rail then three deep nearing the second turn, came out leaving that bend, was fanned five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CONTROL SEEKER stalked outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch, went three deep leaving the second turn, bid outside foes in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. RIDGE DANCE (GB) broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. BOOYAH stalked off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, had his heels clipped leaving that turn, dropped back and came out into the stretch and was eased through the drive and vanned off.
