KOAST had good early speed to duel inside, inched away midway on the hill, came off the rail into the stretch, drifted out a bit in the final furlong but held gamely under urging. FRENEMY chased off the rail then inside on the hill, bid along the fence in the drive, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. IMMACULATE sped to the early lead off the rail then was three deep approaching the right hand curve, stalked off the inside then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and just held third. LA MANO NERA allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and just missed the show. PLENNY OF HENNY angled in and chased the pace along the inside to the stretch, also came out in the drive and lacked the needed rally. CONGRATS SKI had speed between horses then prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked that one just off the rail leaving the hill, was between rivals into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
