TRAPPER'S BOUNTY tossed her head and hopped slightly to be away slowly, moved up inside to stalk the pace, waited off heels leaving the turn, came out for room into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up on the line. YOU CAN DREAM had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between foes on the turn and through most of the stretch, inched away a bit just off the rail in deep stretch and held on well but was edged on the wire. MONA STORM bumped at the start, was between horses early then stalked three deep, bid three wide on the turn and until deep stretch and held third. ABELLA went up inside to duel for the lead, battled along the rail on the turn and until deep stretch and was outfinished. LIL MISS MACKY broke in and bumped a rival, pulled her way between horses to stalk the pace, continued between foes on the turn, was fanned out some and in a bit tight into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. LINE ONE pulled a bit and chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. BONITA SONADOR squeezed back when bumped between horses at the start, angled in and chased inside, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the drive.
