QUEENIE Z settled well off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, found the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and closed gamely under steady handling to prove best. SELF TAUGHT, close up four wide on the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn and just got the place. CITY DOC, broke in and a bit slowly, dueled inside, was no match for the winner and just lost second. COOL MISS ASHLEY, sent between rival on the backstretch, continued off the inside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BUD'S GOLDEN GIRL, dueled outside CITY DOC, gained a short lead in midstretch but weakened. CLASSIC HOLIDAY, was sent between rivals on the backstretch, continued just off the inside and weakened. CHILL'S ROSE, unhurried early, had a rail trip and failed to menace.
