QUEEN MARILES had good early speed outside then set the pace off the rail early, angled in on the hill, fought back when headed in the stretch, regained the advantage and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. ENTABENI had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, bid alongside the winner in the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outgamed to the wire. HIGHER INCENTIVE pulled some and stalked between horses, came out three deep into the stretch and finished willingly. MANHATTAN BEACH (IRE) stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was outfinished but shared fourth. EL NADIA (NZ) settled off the rail, came out leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. LIT DE BET saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch, continued inside and could not offer the necessary response. ANGELS' SHARE chased between horses or a bit off the rail, split rivals again leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DISH THE DIRT pulled between horses then outside, went between foes again leaving the hill and alongside a rival into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and did not rally. YOU CAN DREAM chased outside then fell back at the right hand curve, came on again three deep leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch, steadied off heels in upper stretch and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
