Footnotes

HIGHLY FAVOURED a bit slow to begin, went up between horses to duel for the lead, continued a bit off the rail leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held under urging. WILLIS unhurried outside then off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and continued willingly toward the inside. BIG WAGS stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and turn and held third between foes late. SWISS EMPEROR chased off the rail then outside, came five wide into the stretch and just missed the show outside foes late. SCRUTINIZING KAT had good early speed and dueled four wide on the backstretch and most of the turn, drifted in some in the stretch and was overtaken late for third. TWOATTEN TENATTWO squeezed at the start, chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TEA PARTY TIME had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, came out some into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and could not summon the necessary response. PLAYING FOR KEEPS bumped at the start, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground into and on the turn and did not rally. THRICE THE VICE dueled between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, was in a bit tight nearing the quarter pole and weakened. HENNESSY GOD went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back into and on the turn, fell back a bit leaving the turn and also weakened. HARBOR MARKER broke in

onto foes, settled outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came out some into the stretch and was not a threat. NOBLE ADVOCATE slow into stride, settled inside without early speed and was always outrun.
