Regular nominations close Saturday, March 20, 2010 by payment of \$2,500 each. Closed with 5. All horses shall pay \$7,500 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. Graded or Group winners preferred. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner.

Footnotes

SIDNEY'S CANDY bobbled at the start but broke on top, sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace along the inside, inched away on the second turn and drew off in the stretch under left handed urging and a long hold late. SETSUKO a step slow into stride, settled off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well for the place. LOOKIN AT LUCKY stalked between horses then inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, steadied and was shuffled back midway on that turn, angled out into the stretch, split horses nearing midstretch and came back on toward the inside to best the others. CARACORTADO close up stalking the pace inside, fell back some on the backstretch, steadied off heels just past midway on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. SKIPSHOT four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then off the inside leaving the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. ALPHIE'S BET five wide into the first turn, chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and second turn and lacked the needed rally. THOMAS BAINES pulled his way along inside then chased a bit off the rail, went between horses on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. POSSE POWER came off the rail in the run to the first turn, settled outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, angled five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. WHO'S UP also came off the rail early, stalked just off the inside then between horses, angled to the inside leaving the second turn and weakened. CARDIFF GIANT pulled his way along three deep into the first turn, chased off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run on the second turn but made no change when they ruled that the runners involved in the trouble to LOOKIN AT LUCKY finished behind that rival.
