Footnotes

GRYLLS angled in and chased outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch, collared the runner-up under urging in deep stretch and proved best. SKYSPY stalked outside, bid alongside a rival leaving the turn, put a head in front into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and held second. C R CAPER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch, weakened some late but bested the others. POLISH PETE had speed between horses then stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RICKY EL CORREDOR angled in and settled a bit off the rail, went around a rival leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SWISS ACE between foes early, dueled outside a rival, stalked on the turn, continued a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. GOOD DIRECTION chased inside, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
