LUCKY J. H. stalked inside, came out leaving the hill, split rivals into the stretch, bid between foes in the drive while bumping with EPIC POWER, gained the lead past midstretch and gamely prevailed under some urging with the whip turned down and good handling. HIGH STANDARDS sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled outside a rival, regained a short advantage three deep between foes in midstretch and held second. BESTDRESSED settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and gained the show. DAKOTA PADRE pulled between horses then stalked three deep, bid four wide in the stretch and was outfinished. MCCANN'S MOJAVE pulled between horses then stalked inside leaving the hill, waited off heels some into the stretch and split foes late. CHEROOT cut the corner at the right hand curve then steadied, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EPIC POWER had speed off the rail then stalked the pace, bid inside to put a head in front on the hill, bumped with the winner then steadied in midstretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
