

## SANTA ANITA PARK - April 5, 2003 - Race 6

STAKES Santa Anita Derby Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$250 each to accompany the nomination (Early Bird) on or before December 9, 2002.

Early Bird nominees to the Santa Anita Derby are automatically eligible to both the San Rafael and San Felipe Stakes with nomination and starting fees waived to those two stakes. Late nominations close Thursday, March 13, 2003 by payment of \$2,500 each. Supplementary nominations are due at time of entry, by payment of \$15,000. All horses shall pay \$7,500 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. 149 early noms, 2 late.

### Footnotes

BUDDY GIL settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, moved up on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short advantage in upper stretch and held on gamely under urging. INDIAN EXPRESS dueled outside a rival, put a head in front into the second turn, continued inside on that bend, fought back along the rail through a long, hard drive and continued gamely to the wire. KAFWAIN stalked between horses then off the rail or outside a rival, continued toward the inside into the second turn, waited briefly then split rivals on that turn, came out for room into the stretch and bested the others. ATSWHATIMTALKNBOUT bobbled at the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, came out into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. DOMESTIC DISPUTE stalked the pace outside, bid three deep on the second turn then outside the runner-up, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. LOGICIAN pulled some early, chased three deep on the first turn and outside on the backstretch, dropped back leaving the second turn, was floated well wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased. FLIRT WITH FORTUNE broke awkwardly, pulled his way along off the rail then drifted out into the first turn, went between horses on that bend then chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and also was eased late. IRON LAD (IRE) angled in on the first turn and saved ground stalking the pace, fell back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way, then was not persevered with in the lane. OCEAN TERRACE had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back when headed into the second turn, drifted wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased through the drive.
