Footnotes

TANGLED TANGO prompted the pace three deep to the stretch, continued outside, then surged again between foes under left handed urging to get up. PREMIUM QUALITY stalked four wide then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, angled out off heels in midstretch and finished well. VICTOR'S CRY had speed between foes then dueled inside, inched away in the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging in deep stretch and was caught late. KSAR GHILANE angled in and dueled between horses, stalked off the rail in the stretch, drifted in and steadied off heels a sixteenth out and weakened late. EL LEGADO settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. HOLY HUMOR saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LOTACAT was in a good position chasing the pace between horses to the stretch and lacked a further response. KAFFEINATOR chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. LITTLE DUDE stalked just off the inside then angled in for the turn, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened. QUIET WARRIOR settled outside a rival then angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and failed to menace.
