YANKEE VISIONARY stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, angled out again under urging in midstretch and closed willingly to get up on the line. BAD BIG AL stalked between horses then bid between foes on the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and held on gamely but was edged late. HIGH INTELLECT stalked outside foes then bid three deep on the turn, put a head in front in midstretch and continued willingly to best the others. QUIITYERBELLYACHING chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. ROAR OF EAGLES squeezed at the start, settled inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and found his best stride late. SOLO PERFORMANCE wide early, angled in outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and six wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. PROFESSNL COURTESY chased outside, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WAAFI angled in and chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch, went between horses in midstretch and was not a threat. MOUNTAIN ROUTE saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. EXOTIC STORY sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, angled in and duelled for command on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BERT'S LAW chased between horse then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened.
