BELLE PASSE pulled her way along to stalk outside then moved up between horses, bid alongside the runner-up leaving the hill, took the lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under a left handed tap of the whip and a vigorous hand ride. HIDINGINPLAINSIGHT saved ground stalking the pace, bid between horses nearing midstretch then inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. LADY FAIRBANKS stalked toward the inside then between horses, split rivals in midstretch and gained the show. MIA ISABEL chased outside then four wide on the hill and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VEGAS BABE went up inside a rival to the lead then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back leaving the hill and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CLODHOPPER (IRE) a half step slow to begin, pulled her way between horses to chase the pace, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. VUKOVAR had good early speed off the rail, stalked outside then four wide, continued three deep leaving the hill, dropped back between foes approaching the stretch, drifted out some into the lane and had little left for the drive. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
