Footnotes

EVER ALERT stalked off the rail, bid between horses to gain the lead midway on the second turn, inched away leaving that turn, kicked clear inside under left handed urging in the stretch and proved best. CAPTAIN CORRIGAN a bit wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but was clearly second best. SWISS EMPEROR saved ground chasing the pace, split horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and just got the show. PATRIOTIC LION sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, dueled midway on the second turn, fell back some nearing the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and just lost third. BOB GRECO three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and second turn and lacked the needed rally. GABBRO GLITZ chased outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch, split rivals on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. EVERLASTING MAN settled a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the second turn, went three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch, drifted in and was not a threat. HEAVENLY ROAD saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn, came out in the stretch and gave way.
