Early Bird nominees to the Santa Anita Derby are automatically eligible to both the San Rafael and San Felipe Stakes with nomination and starting fees waived to those two stakes. Late nominations close Thursday, February 28, 2002 by payment of \$2,500 each. Supplementary nominations are due at time of entry, by payment of \$15,000. All horses shall pay \$15,000 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. Footnotes

CAME HOME stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses in upper stretch, gained a short lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under urging and strong handling while drifting in some late. EASY GRADES wide early, chased outside, advanced three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid three across the track in the lane, could not match the winner but held second. LUSTY LATIN bumped at the start, raced unhurried off the inside, came wide into the stretch and gained the show late. MAYAKOVSKY stumbled at the start but recovered and pulled his way to the front, angled in and set the pace along the inside, fought back in the stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth and lost third late. U S S TINOSA squeezed a bit at the start, steadied when in tight into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, went three deep into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. JACK'S SILVER in tight along the inside into the first turn, came off the rail and settled on the backstretch, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PROUD CITIZEN stalked the pace outside the winner, fell back some leaving the second turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN broke out and bumped with LUSTY LATIN, was rank between horses and in tight into the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail, bid inside leaving the backstretch, also dropped back some on the second turn and also weakened.
