Footnotes

CAT TALK came off the rail on the first turn, moved up three deep then bid alongside the runner-up and dueled for the lead, put a head in front past midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. DON PERICO sent between foes early, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. SLAMMER TIME saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the show late. CIRCLE THE MOON three deep into the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was edged late for third. ACCELERANT saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch then angled back in and was outfinished for a minor award. KILLER BEAR broke a bit awkwardly settled just off the rail then outside a rival, angled in leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TWIN SIX had speed between horses then stalked outside a rival, continued between foes leaving the second turn and weakened. SPRING FORTH settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. QUAIL HILL angled in three deep then bid between horses into the backstretch, stalked just off the rail to the stretch and weakened.
