JIMMY CREED had good early speed and pressed the pace outside a rival, took a short lead nearing the stretch, inched away a bit off the rail in the drive and held on gamely under urging. UNBRIDLED'S NOTE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and finished well but could not catch the winner. APRIORITY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep then outside the runner-up on the turn, bid three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick but held third. COMMA TO THE TOP broke out a bit, sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. CAMP VICTORY broke slowly and awkwardly, chased just off the rail, came out some in the stretch but lacked the needed rally. SECOND CITY angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
