ANGEL GIFT off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, moved up on the turn, came out in midstretch and rallied under confident handling to gain the lead in deep stretch, then pulled clear. HAWKSVILLE forced or stalked the pace outside a rival, put a head in front leaving the turn, fought off the bid of SMART START in the stretch but could not hold off the winner. SMART START close up outside or off the rail on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, bid into the stretch, drew even in midstretch but settled for the show. CONTINENTAL LU saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and just missed third. MISS SKAGIT STATE sent between horses to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn and into the stretch, then weakened. MILAGRA stalked the pace a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and also weakened. VALIANT ALLIE was in a good position outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and also weakened. MOON'S TUNE allowed to settle outside or off the rail to the stretch, did not rally. JANUARY'S STORM without early speed a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival into and on the turn and failed to menace.
