Footnotes

SPYCAT bumped at the start, went between rivals early, settled off the rail, angled in for the turn and moved up, came out past midstretch and rallied gamely under some urging. DOC GUS also bumped at the start, settled outside, also angled to the inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, lugged in past midstretch, then came out and surged late. PRIMA NOCTI dueled outside a rival to the stretch, inched away in the drive but was caught late. FRENCH WARPAINt bumped at the start, unhurried a bit off the rail early, split horses into the turn, angled in some past midstretch and rallied between horses late. HEMET THOUGHT squeezed a bit at the start, chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, was three deep in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. LUCKY BALDWIN broke out onto rivals, dueled along the inside to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CITY OF RICHES saved ground chasing the dueling leaders, came out into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed response. HIGH AND LOW VIXEN broke out a bit and steadied in the early strides, was taken off the rail early, went three deep on the turn and did not menace. MARKET CAP chased off the rail or outside on the backstretch, dropped back three deep on the turn and weakened. CHINOIS off a bit slowly and squeezed at the start, saved ground and failed to menace.
