### Footnotes

LINE ONE was off a bit slowly, recovered and pulled her way along on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, swung outside at the top of the lane, rallied three deep inside the sixteenth pole and was up for the score at the wire. QUEENIE MARINI chased between horses in the early going, remained off the rail around the turn, was under urging approaching the quarter pole, had the rider lose his whip in midstretch, rallied between horses in the final yards and gained the place at the wire. CHOCOLATE CALIENTE sped to the early lead, dueled outside SPARROW into the turn, inched clear on the turn, remained clear in midstretch and was worn down in the final furlong and lost the place on the wire. SPARROW dueled inside CHOCOLATE CALIENTE down the backstretch, lost touch with that one around the turn, angled off the rail into the stretch, came back inside in the final yards and went willingly to the wire between foes. LAKE OSCEOLA chased three deep on the backstretch, remained off the rail around the turn, swung to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and could not mount a rally.
