Footnotes

RON BURGUNDY chased between horses, bid three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch, gained a slim advantage nearing midstretch, battled outside a rival in the final furlong and held between foes late under urging. GALITZIANER moved up between rivals on the backstretch, bid between foes

into and on the turn and into the stretch, fought back a bit off the rail in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. SWISS GAME stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished with interest three deep on the line. TALE BE TOLD sent between horses early, angled in and chased outside a rival or between foes, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, swung out into the stretch and also finished well. MIDNIGHT CON a bit slow to begin, moved up inside on the backstretch, steadied when trying to go between foes into the turn, continued just off the rail, split horses in midstretch and continued willingly late but was outfinished. WARRENS BIG SIPPER chased between horses then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. BESPOKE SUIT squeezed a bit at the start, settled just off the rail to the stretch and improved position in the drive. RICO ESPADA sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the turn and until nearing the eighth pole and weakened. TARSUS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. NO LOOKIN' BACK had speed outside then stalked outside rivals, fell back on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. TAYLOR MARINI a bit slow to begin, went up between horses on the backstretch, bid between foes then was in tight into the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and also weakened. J V M BOY pulled his way along inside and steadied five eighths out, stalked along the rail, steadied again into the turn, dropped back and had little left for the stretch. LONDONMAV chased outside, dropped back while being pulled up leaving the backstretch and was walked off.
