RISKY REWARD angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, split foes a quarter mile out, angled out in upper stretch, bid three deep, gained a short lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear late under urging. QATAR'S PEARL angled to the inside then came out into the backstretch, settled outside a rival, swung three deep into the stretch and gained the place late. CURRAHEE pulled his way along three deep then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back between foes in midstretch, could not match the winner late and just lost second while drifting in late. AQUA REVELATION also pulled between horses then stalked just off the rail, angled in for the second turn and weakened in the stretch. LANGFURS LIGHTNING between foes early, sped to the lead and angled in, set the pace inside, took an awkward step nearing the quarter pole, fought back when challenged until past midstretch and weakened late. EVER ALERT settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. MONTEGO BAY four wide early, angled in off the rail chasing the pace, went outside a rival on the backstretch and three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. MAJESTIC MOMENT broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside then a bit out from the rail to the stretch and was not a threat.
