GO GO angled right early and cut the corner at the right hand curve, settled off the rail, split horses nearing the dirt, came out four wide into the stretch and closed gamely under a crack of the whip and confident handling to prove best. SEPARATA (CHI) quickly sped to the lead, angled in a bit off the rail on the hill, set the pace, held on well to deep stretch but could not contain the winner. DIANEHILL (IRE) settled toward the inside then moved up outside a rival down the hill, came three deep into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and just held third. AL DESIMA (GB) trailed without early speed, angled in down the hill and saved ground, split horses in upper stretch, came out and just missed the show. PENNY MARIE chased outside a rival then angled in leaving the hill, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked a late response. NANOGRAM allowed to settle outside on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SOUTHERN HOUSE (IRE) well placed stalking the pace along the inside, steadied leaving the hill and weakened. BRITE GIRL angled in and stalked the pace inside, tried to go inside the runner-up but steadied behind the trees, lugged out some on the dirt and also weakened.
