Footnotes

PARTY PIRATE sped to the early lead, angled in after the right hand curve, set the pace along the inside and won clear under some urging. BROCKY'S DREAM (AUS) cut the corner at the right hand curve then stalked outside a rival, continued between horses leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and just got the place. OUR FLING (NZ) between horses early, stalked inside, came out into the stretch and just lost second. CHOSEN HONOR stalked toward the inside then outside a rival, went three deep leaving the hill and a bit wider into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. KISSING GIRL (ARG) settled off the rail then angled in and saved ground chasing the pace and lacked the necessary response. MONTANA BANANA between horses early, stalked outside then three deep down the hill, swung five wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at seven feet.
