**Footnotes**

SPRING FESTIVAL had good early speed between horses, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, drifted out despite right handed urging in the stretch but won clear. PARIS NEXT YEAR sent between rivals early, stalked the pace outside a foe then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled inward in deep stretch and just held second. SILVER FIZZ chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, moved up outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. SILVER MIRACLE settled a bit off the rail, split foes on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and improved position in the stretch. FESTIVAL OF FUN chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CANDYMAN'S GIRL settled in midpack outside on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. FIRST ROCK saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. MAI PURPLE close up stalking the pace along the inside, dropped back on the turn and weakened. MI CARAMELO chased between foes then a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn and had little left for the stretch. PRETTY BLUE EYES broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun.
