Footnotes

TERROPLANE (FR) saved ground chasing the pace, bid along the rail into the stretch, gained the advantage under some left handed urging in deep stretch and pulled clear. RUNNING FREE four wide into the first turn, angled in a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the second turn, circled four wide into the stretch, gained command three deep in midstretch but could not match the winner. BONFANTE sent to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away from foes leaving the second turn, battled between horses in midstretch and held third. RUN AT NIGHT angled in and stalked the early pace off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued between foes into the stretch and weakened. CAPITANO fractious in the gate, pulled his way along early, stalked between horses on the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn and also weakened in the lane. KINGDOM COME (IRE) also pulled early, stalked three deep on the first turn then off the rail leaving the backstretch, continued between foes on the second turn, dropped back and also weakened.
