Footnotes

DESIGNED FOR LUCK stalked the pace outside a rival down the hill, took a short lead outside the pacesetter nearing midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. MAYBE MIKE sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back when challenged in the stretch but could not quite match the winner late. CLONMANY (IRE) bumped at the start, saved ground down the hill, moved up inside into the stretch and continued gamely for third while unable to catch the top pair. DOUBLE FOREIGNER bumped at the start, chased outside a rival down the hill, came out three deep into the stretch and was nipped for the show. SUNLIT GOLD was without early speed saving ground down the hill, came out a bit into the stretch, steadied briefly to avoid the fallen rider in upper stretch and did not rally. AMIR stalked the early pace along the inside, dropped back leaving the hill, came out into the stretch, then broke down in upper stretch and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry before determining that AMIR was racing in the clear before breaking down of his own accord.
