Footnotes

DELAVALLADE stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead three across the coarse past the eighth pole, drifted inward in deep stretch but proved best under urging. REAL BLONDE chased inside, waited behind rivals leaving the hill, got through along the rail with a bid in the stretch but could not quite match the winner late. WHY KNOTT ME TOO cut the corner at the right hand curve then chased outside, angled in leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and gained the show late. CROSSFIELD sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back between horses in the drive, steadied momentarily in tight behind the winner in deep stretch and lost third late. HAWTHORNE LANE pulled a bit early, chased a bit off the rail down the hill and lacked the needed rally. LOVER COME BACK stalked toward the inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. HOLY REQUEST a bit crowded after the start, chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the hill and did not rally. PASEANA'S GIRL (ARG) allowed to settle just off the inside, came out crossing the dirt and failed to menace. Rail on hill at seven feet.
