BERBATIM stalked the leader inside, bid alongside that one and took command on the second turn, kicked clear, angled in and proved best under some urging and steady handling. ROYAL COPENHAGEN (FR) chased a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, bid inside in the stretch and was second best. THATSWHATIMEAN stalked the pace outside a rival, bid between foes then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. SINGHALESE (GB) bumped and forced out at the start, angled in outside a rival then settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. SHINING ENERGY broke out and bumped a rival, pulled her way along to chase three deep, went four wide into and on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, drifted in late and lacked a further response. CRYSTAL HOUSE saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary rally. ON LONDON TIME stalked between horses, was in tight into the stretch and did not rally. CLEFT off a bit slowly, pulled under a hold early, trailed inside, came out on the second turn, also was in tight between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed response. THANKS rank and steady in the run to the first turn, stalked inside, was in tight into the second turn then shuffled back leaving that bend and weakened. GUARANTEED VICTORY pulled her way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into the second turn, dropped back leaving that bend and gave way.
