**Footnotes**

REVEALED settled off the rail down the hill, came out in upper stretch and closed gamely while drifting in to get up on the wire. QUICKFIRE (GB) chased off the inside then angled in on the hill, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, gained the lead outside a foe past midstretch and just failed to hold off the winner. ALL AGLOW had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear in the stretch and held third. DYNALOOK chased along the inside, came out a bit in upper stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPY ALY dueled outside a rival down the hill and weakened in the stretch. DANCING ROSE (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and improved position. HOTESSE (CHI) allowed to settle outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and did not rally. DOMINIQUE DARLING stalked the dueling leaders along the inside to the stretch and weakened. CREAM DONUT KEITH was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and also weakened. MS. PURR pulled her way along to chase between horses, steadied in tight in upper stretch and gave way. Rail on hill at zero.
