DEFYING LOGIC prompted the pace three deep then stalked on the turn, re-bid alongside a rival in the stretch, gained a slim advantage past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under left handed urging between foes late. WHITE LACE JIMMY angled in and stalked inside, waited off heels in midstretch, came out and bid between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. DEFENSE KING stalked the pace a bit off the rail, waited off heels leaving the turn, came out three deep into the stretch, waited again in midstretch, angled out for room and bid outside foes then also went on willingly between foes late. MAKING DREAMS broke outward, sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the turn, fought back along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. FLATTER ME AGAIN a bit crowded at the start, pulled his way up a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DOGGIE BEAR prompted the pace between horses, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, dropped back between foes into the stretch and weakened.
