Footnotes

NANA BOO sent along to the early lead, drifted in when clear and proved much the best under steady handling. FERRANDERO a half step slow to begin, was sent between rivals then chased outside a foe and was game for second. ANITA BREWSKI bumped early, was sent between horses then chased off the rail and held third. ACTION CALL drifted in early, chased in midtrack and was outfinished for a minor award. RAY'S STORM away a bit awkwardly, drifted in early and lacked a rally. GREAT WHEELS broke a bit slowly and was squeezed and lacked the needed response. EL RANCHERO came out and bumped a rival early, lugged out in midstretch and was eased up late. WARREN'S ANDREW broke alertly and was sent between foes but was in tight in upper stretch, then angled in and failed to menace. HAPPY M. B. A. broke slowly, raced toward the inside and was always outrun. NO WHIPS OR BLINKERS WERE ALLOWED.
