Footnotes

LIBERIAN FREIGHTER reluctant to enter the turf course, had speed outside foes then angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, found the fence on the backstretch, inched away on the second turn and held on gamely under urging. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) chased just off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied between horses late. JERANIMO angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and also finished well between foes in the final stages. NORVSKY pulled between horses then along the inside early, stalked just off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and went on willingly while splitting horses on the line. CARACORTADO allowed to settle off the pace inside, saved ground until nearing the stretch, came out into the lane and again in upper stretch and found his best stride late outside rivals. RUN IT settled outside then alongside a foe, came out some in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LEROY'S DYMEAUX unhurried outside a rival for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
