BIG WIG stalked outside foes then alongside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch, inched away and held sway under some left handed urging and strong handling. WARREN'S TONY R. chased inside then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. FIRE BREAK prompted the pace outside a rival, bid again leaving the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and until past midstretch and held third. ON THE VIRG between foes early, angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and just missed the show. SQUALLCREEK pulled a bit while setting a pressured pace inside under a snug hold, inched away briefly into the second turn, fought back along the rail into and through the stretch and weakened late.
