**Footnotes**

CHAMPAGNE TOPPER pulled his way to the early lead and angled over to the inside into the first turn, retained the advantage on the inside throughout and held off WARREN'S WAREHOUSE through the final furlong. WARREN'S WAREHOUSE went into the first turn three wide, chased outside or three deep down the backstretch, remained three wide around the second turn, bid alongside the winner into and through the stretch and was denied while a clear second at the wire. LEYVA MAN broke very slowly behind his field angled over to save some ground around the first turn, chased outside REGAL FEVER for much of the journey, was forced out leaving the second turn and could make no impact in the lane. REGAL FEVER chased on the inside for most of the journey and was edged for the show in the late stages. RUN CANDY RUN was between horses around the first turn, inside a rival or between horses down the backstretch and into the second turn, steadied between foes nearing the quarter pole while being pulled up and was eased through the final furlong. ORBACH was reserved and outrun down the backstretch, swung out on the second turn, slipped and fell at the quarter pole, then was vanned off. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident at the quarter pole and ruled ORBACH fell of his own accord.
