Footnotes

SLIGHT EDGE chased outside then three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best. NONNO TUNAGA had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, could not match the winner late but bested the others. NEUROSURGEON bumped after the start, chased between horses then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival late for the show. GREY IS BEST had speed between rivals then dueled outside a foe, stalked leaving the turn, drifted three deep into the stretch and lost third late. SILECTICO bumped and squeezed some at the start, stalked off the rail then between foes leaving the turn and weakened. STORM BID broke in and bumped a rival, chased between foes then off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and also weakened.
