**Footnotes**

MUSICAL HIGH (IRE) pulled a bit early, stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch to gain the lead past the eighth pole, inched away and held gamely under some urging. PAPARAZZI CHARM (NZ) saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, came out past midstretch and finished well. BIEN DULCE (ARG) steadied between horses early, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, angled in and gained the show late along the rail. USK POPPY (GB) stalked outside then between horses, split rivals three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. SWEET SPOT (GB) sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, battled outside the winner in midstretch and weakened late. TRICK A CAT stalked the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. IN REALITY (GB) stalked outside, went four wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. TOTALLY PHAT settled a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DYNAMATIC stalked outside a rival then between foes, was shuffled back some leaving the second turn and weakened.
