Footnotes

BATTLE OF HASTINGS (GB) four wide into the first turn, chased between horses then outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to the front in deep stretch and proved best. SMOKEY LONESOME chased inside then between horses on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, waited momentarily then spit horses with a bid in midstretch, gained the lead, fought back inside and held second. WALL STREET WONDER angled in and forced then stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch and bested the others. CHARLIE'S MOMENT pulled between horses early, drifted out into the first turn, forced the pace three deep then between rivals on the backstretch, battled outside a rival on the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back between foes in midstretch and weakened late. DAPPER GENE settled inside chasing the pace, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ARDEN PARK settled outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came out leaving that bend, was fanned six wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) pulled early, chased between horses, came out four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed rally. LESSON IN DECEIT broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside then off the rail, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat. MR. MONKEY JONES had speed three deep then duled between horses on the first turn and inside on the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ROBS HERO fanned four wide into the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch, stalked on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened.
